Important Show Information

SANCTIONED Entries/payment closes on and should be postmarked by June 20th , 2026. Post Entries will be accepted, but entries by due date are greatly appreciated. Post Entry Fee is \$10 per horse.

OPEN classes can also register on Saturday, BEFORE the show starts at 8 A.M.

Move in date/Move out date: Move in date is Thursday, July 9th at noon, and move out date is Sunday, July 12th at the end of the show.

All horses should be sound and in good health. Updated vaccinations are highly recommended. Horses coming in from out of state required a health certificate and negative coggins test.

Measuring will be conducted: July 9th from 5:00 to 7:00 pm and each morning before the show as needed. Exhibitors showing *** **unregistered** *** horses Saturday should use horse measuring sticks located at the arena entrance to determine horse height. Miniature horse: under 38" or Pony: over 38".

This is a sanctioned ASPC/AMHR/ASPR/NSPPR show. Classes are only open to horses registered with ASPC/AMHR/ASPR/NSPPR. The **only exception** to this rule is those open classes which start with *** on Saturday. These classes are for non-registered mini horses and shetlands.

All entries must accompany payment before they will be entered into the system. Back numbers and day sheets will be issued Thursday evening after your horses have been measured.

Stalls will be pre-assigned. Stalls are panels, cement floor, and are roughly 10 X 10 in size. Stall fees are \$70 for the show or \$25 per day.

Shavings this year will be loose and already in each stall. More can be purchased at \$5 a wheelbarrow. A wheelbarrow and a shovel will be available. There is a maximum of two horses per stall. Horses must be stalled or confined to a trailer for those showing in Open non-registered classes on Saturday.

Stalls this year **MUST** be cleaned out before contestants leave the fairgrounds; \$35 per horse will be charged if not. We are working on possibly having some high school students at the fairgrounds on Sunday, who contestants could hire to clean their stalls.

Stalls are located facing the arena entrance. Wash racks are available; please only use that area to wash. There may be hoses, but not guaranteed. Please provide your own hose.

Practice jumps, and some obstacles will be made available for use to practice.

Camping: There are restrooms and free showers on the fairgrounds. Most camping spots have electrical and water hookups and are on the East side of the river.

Dogs are allowed, but must always be on a leash. Please clean up after animal.

Live dogs will be allowed in the Dog Carriage class, but they must be **on a leash** and well-mannered at all times. Please clean up after your animal.

Ring Procedure: Management shall expect all ASPC/AMHR exhibitors to have familiarized themselves with the official rule book of the ASPC/AMHR. Any horse that becomes a threat to an exhibitor, audience or other animal may be asked to be removed from the show grounds.

Two-minute gate rule: Once the class has been announced, the gate personnel will begin timing for all entries to enter. There will be no refund for missed classes. It shall be the exhibitor's responsibility to watch the progression of the show.

Show staff will make every effort to ensure you are aware of your upcoming class, **BUT**, it is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to barn areas are a management courtesy – not mandatory.

Gate holds: Gate holds must be requested to the gate personnel 4 classes in advance and in writing. Gate holds will be a maximum of 2 minutes, 5 minutes for harness changes.

Changing classes: Exhibitors must fill out class change forms, which should be done the night before morning classes or in the morning before afternoon classes.

Lunch/breaks: Will be left to the discretion of the judges. However, they will not break until a division is complete, i.e., if they are judging a yearling mare class, lunch will not be held until the grand champion class has been completed, etc.

Each entry must include completed copy of the MWMHSPO Summary Entry Form, one ASPC/AMHR/ASPR/NSPPR Entry form for each horse, copy of current/up-to-date registration papers (front & back) for each horse, copy of measurement card for each horse, copies of amateur or youth card if applicable, signed Disclosure form and payment for total entries, stalls, shavings, etc.

Amateur classes: You must possess a current year amateur card to show in amateur classes and provide a copy to the show manager with your entries. Applications for Amateur and Youth memberships will be available at the show.

NO refunds on stall fees.

NO refunds on scratched/missed classes. However, you may swap one scratched/missed class for another if the same cost or pay the additional cost for the new class.

Class entry fees will only be refunded upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate.

Any special requests must be included with the entry and approved by the club presidency.

All exhibitors who incurred additional costs during the show (new classes, extra shavings, auction bids, etc.) **MUST** reconcile their bill before leaving the show on Sunday, July 12th. PLEASE settle up with the show manager before leaving! No post-payments after the show are allowed.

Any entry or class mailed or emailed will constitute an official entry, and payment must be made.

Checks returned for non-sufficient funds shall incur a \$35 return check fee.

No smoking in stalls or buildings.

Judges, Stewards, and Show Evaluation Sheets will be available in the show office and may be completed voluntarily.

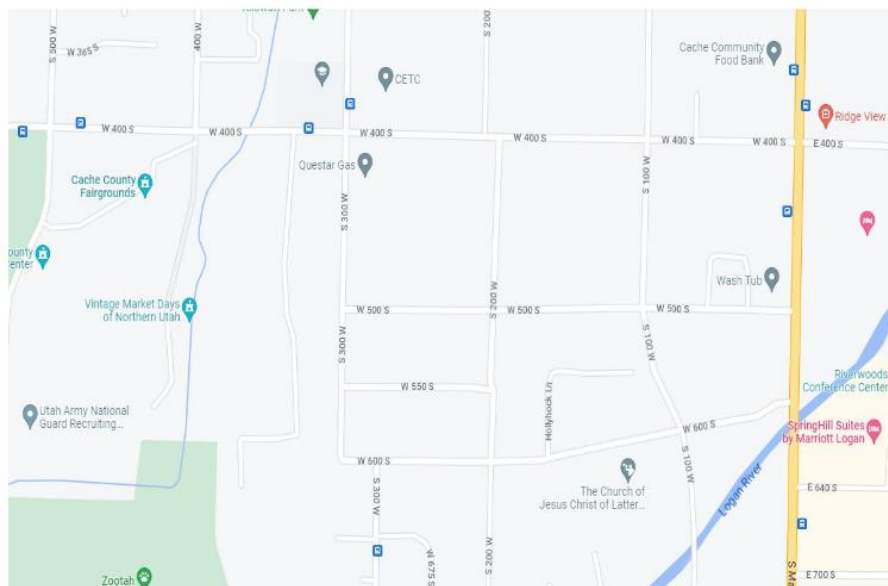

MWMHSPO Disclosure statement
